

ORDINANCE NO. 93-3 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF
CUSTIS INSURANCE SERVICE, INC., OF SHEFFIELD LAKE, OHIO,
FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN
AND AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of the following insurance company and its
agent, being the lowest and best bid for supplying certain insurance coverage
for the City of Oberlin, be and the same is hereby accepted and the Interim
City Manager is authorized to enter into a contact accordingly:

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of
this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were
adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this
Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal
requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety
of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to obtain necessary insurance coverage for the City of Oberlin at
the earliest possible date"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
