

ORDINANCE NO. 93-52 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF JACK MAXTON CHEVROLET OF WORTHINGTON, OHIO, FOR TWO (2) POLICE CRUISERS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN POLICE DEPARTMENT AND A 1/2 TON PICKUP TRUCK FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN SEWER DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Jack Maxton Chevrolet of Worthington, Ohio, for two (2) police cruisers for the City of Oberlin Police Department and a 1/2 ton pickup truck for the City of Oberlin Sewer Department, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$41,921.00

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to authorize the acceptance of a pending bid prior to its expiration."
