

ORDINANCE NO. 93-75 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING SECTION 141.03 OF THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, RELATING TO A
UNIFORM ALLOWANCE FOR OFFICERS OF THE
OBERLIN POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 141.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, which authorized each regular police officer of the Oberlin Police Department to receive \$300 during each fiscal year as an allowance for uniforms, equipment and telephones, is hereby rescinded.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
