

RESOLUTION NO. R93-11 AC CMS

A RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, TO CONFORM THE BOUNDARIES OF OBERLIN TOWNSHIP WITH THE PRESENT CORPORATION LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, PURSUANT TO SECTION 503.07 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

WHEREAS, on November 3, 1993, annexation proceedings were completed which annexed approximately 190.935 acres of real property in Pittsfield Township to the City of Oberlin; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin previously established Oberlin Township, the boundaries of which were identical with the corporate limits of the City of Oberlin; and,

WHEREAS, said recently annexed real property will remain in Pittsfield Township unless the City of Oberlin petitions the Board of Lorain County Commissioners to conform the boundaries of Oberlin Township with the new corporation limits of the City so as to include said property within Oberlin Township; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Oberlin to so conform the boundaries of Oberlin Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, pursuant to Section 503.07 of the Ohio Revised Code, hereby respectfully petitions the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, to change the boundaries of Oberlin Township to make them identical with the present corporation limits of the City of Oberlin. The portions of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, not now included within the limits of Oberlin Township include those portions of Pittsfield Township annexed to the City of Oberlin by Ordinance No. 93-65 AC CMS.


SECTION 2. That the City Solicitor is hereby designated as agent of the City of Oberlin to present said petition to the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, and to do all things necessary and proper on behalf of the City of Oberlin to accomplish the purpose of this Resolution, such to be charged to the City of Oberlin as extraordinary services.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
