

ORDINANCE NO. 94-103 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 94-2 AC CMS
TO ALLOW THE CITY TO PICK-UP UNSCHEDULED LARGE
TRASH AND BILL THE RESIDENT OR HOME OWNER
FOR THE SAME

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 94-2 AC CMS, as it relates to large trash pickups, is hereby amended to add the following language relative to unscheduled large trash pick-up:

925.06 LARGE TRASH PICKUP

...

(d) Each residential property shall be entitled to one scheduled free large trash pickup per year. Additional large trash pickup service shall be available at a rate as established by Council. Large trash items placed for collection where a large trash collection has not been scheduled may, at the option of the City, be collected and the resident or homeowner billed for an unscheduled collection.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
