

ORDINANCE NO. 94-15 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE OPEN SPACE
AND CONSERVATION COMMISSION TO THE OPEN SPACE AND
VISUAL ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Open Space and Conservation Commission has, by ordinance, assumed the duties of the now-abolished Committee on Visual Environment; and,

WHEREAS, the name of the Open Space and Conservation Commission should be modified to reflect the addition of those new duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the name of the Open Space and Conservation Commission of Oberlin Ohio, as established by Ordinance No. 683 AC, is hereby changed to the "Open Space and Visual Environment Commission".

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
