AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$8388.00 FROM THE CABLE COMMUNICATIONS PROGRAMMING FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF LOCAL CABLE PROGRAMMING EQUIPMENT, EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE AND SUPPLIES AND PROGRAMMING LABOR
