ORDINANCE NO. 94-49 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CLAUD TURNBULL OF WAKEMAN, OHIO, FOR GRAVEL, LIMESTONE, SAND, AND PLAY AREA EXCAVATION AND GRADING FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN SPRING STREET PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Claud Turnbull of Wakeman, Ohio, for gravel, limestone, sand, play area excavation and grading for the City of Oberlin Spring Street Park Improvement Project in an amount not to exceed \$3,465.50

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to proceed with the proposed Spring Street Park Improvements as soon as possible in order to assure the completion of same prior to the summer of 1994"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
