ORDINANCE NO. 94-90 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER FOR
THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND GUTTFRS ON SOUTH MAIN ST.
BY SMITH PAVING OF NORWALK, OHIO AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to approve an adjustment to cost on the Main Street Curb and Gutter installation and replacement project in the amount of \$24,242.68.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to immediately authorize an adjustment to the total cost in the contract with Smith Paving, hired to install and replace curbs and gutters on South Main Street in order to allow for partial reimbursement of costs by the Ohio Public Works Commission and shall take effect immediately upon passage"
