

RESOLUTION NO. R94-14 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE
CITY SOLICITOR TO REPRESENT THE CITY OF OBERLIN IN
REGARD TO A CHARGE OF DISCRIMINATION PRESENTLY PENDING
BEFORE THE FEDERAL EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to represent the City of Oberlin in a charge of discrimination filed by Ferdinand Garcia Jr. on October 19, 1994, and presently pending before the Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, and conduct any and all investigations, discovery and other proceedings in said matter as he deems appropriate, all to be charged as extraordinary expense to the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:


"to provide for the immediate defense of the City in a pending charge of discrimination before the Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Commission"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
