

RESOLUTION NO. R94-16

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE RECYCLING AND LITTER PREVENTION PROGRAM PURSUANT TO THE OHIO LITTER CONTROL ACT OF 1980, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Oberlin City Council recognizes the need to address recycling and/or litter prevention concerns within the boundaries of the City of Oberlin and the need to address this at the local level; and,

WHEREAS, the Ohio Litter Control Act of 1980 provides, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Recycling and Litter Prevention, for the allocation of funds in the form of grants for the purposes of supplemental local Recycling and Litter Prevention programs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths), of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of Oberlin, Ohio, hereby endorses and supports a 1995 Special Project Recycling and Litter Prevention Grant Program for the Smith Street Reconstruction Project, and authorizes the necessary funds to implement said program, if approved, as indicated in its application.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to apply for and, if awarded enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to administer a grant to implement said program.

SECTION 3. That the City Council of Oberlin, Ohio, hereby requests the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Recycling and Litter Prevention, to consider and fund its program as described in the application.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"In order to allow timely application for funding, the deadline for which is December 31, 1994."

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
