

RESOLUTION R94-3

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE RENEWAL
OF THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS
ISSUE TWO PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission Issue Two Program was authorized by the electorate for ten rounds; and

WHEREAS, the Issue Two Program is presently in its eighth round; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Oberlin have benefitted from the Issue Two program through improvements to streets, sanitary sewers, water treatment, and the drainage system; and

WHEREAS, these improvement would not have been possible without the assistance of the Ohio Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, there are plans to place the program on the ballot for renewal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The City to Oberlin urges the placement of a renewal issue on the May, 1994, ballot and encourages the passage of this renewal by the electorate.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION . That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
