

RESOLUTION NO. R94-7 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE LORAIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES RECYCLE OHIO PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, 5/7ths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin, Ohio, hereby requests that the Commissioners of Lorain County apply to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for a 1995 Recycle, Ohio, grant for the benefit of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That the application to be filed by the Lorain County Commissioners shall be to finance improvements to the City's recycling program as described in the application.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To file a grant application within the time period set by the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Recycling & Litter Prevention"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
