

ORDINANCE NO. 95-114 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF SHARON MILLER AS CLERK OF
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the resignation of Sharon Miller as Clerk of the City Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, dated November 20, 1995, is hereby accepted, effective immediately.

SECTION 2. Sharon Miller will, upon separation from service from the City, receive her accumulated but unused vacation and sick leave pay in lump sum and one accumulated but unused Holiday pay.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to accept the resignation of the Clerk as soon as possible in order to ensure an orderly and efficient transition in the office of the Clerk of City Council"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
