

ORDINANCE NO. 95-123 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 93-1 AC CMS
WHICH APPOINTED SHARON MILLER AS TREASURER
OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 93-1 AC CMS which, among other things, appointed Sharon Miller Treasurer of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, is hereby rescinded and said position is hereby declared vacant.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to Wit:

"to vacate the seat of Treasurer of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, as soon as possible in order to appoint a successor Treasurer to ensure the efficient operation of municipal government"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
