

ORDINANCE NO. 95-21 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 93-1 AC CMS,
AS IT RELATES TO COMPENSATION FOR
THE CLERK OF OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 1995, the Clerk of Oberlin City Council shall work 50 hours per two (2) week pay period (including attendance at all City Council meetings), and receive compensation at the rate of \$10.29 per hour. Fringe benefits shall include participation in PERS, all City paid holidays (based on 5 hours per day) as set forth in section 145.12 of the codified ordinances, and provided vacation allowance as provided in section 145.11(d) of the codified ordinances.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Oberlin City Council shall immediately receive a one-time lump sum pay adjustment in the amount of \$35.80.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to Wit:

"to enact a negotiated pay adjustment for the Clerk of Council at the earliest possible date"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
