## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF D. B. CONCRETE, INC. OF NEW LONDON, OHIO FOR CONCRETE SIDEWALK, CONSTRUCTION AND REPLACEMENT FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of D. B. Concrete, Inc., of New London, Ohio, for concrete sidewalk construction and replacement, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said contract to be in an amount not to exceed \$130,000.00 accordance with the bid item prices as set forth in their bid.
