

ORDINANCE NO. 95-48 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 95-40 AC CMS
WHICH ACCEPTED THE BID OF UNDERGROUND UTILITIES, INC.,
OF MONROVILLE, OHIO, FOR THE PHASE "A" WATER LINE IMPROVEMENT
PROJECT TO CORRECT A TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR IN THE
STATED BID AMOUNT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The Ordinance No. 95-40 AC CMS, which accepted the bid of Underground Utilities, Inc., of Monroville, Ohio, for the Phase "A" water line improvement project is hereby amended to correct a typographical error in the stated bid amount, the correct bid amount to be \$402,813.94

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to correct a typographical error in the ordinance accepting a bid to authorize the project to proceed as soon as possible"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
