

ORDINANCE NO. 95-59 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SIEMENS ENERGY AND AUTOMATION, INC.,
OF AKRON, OHIO, FOR CERTAIN EQUIPMENT FOR
THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER SYSTEM
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Siemens Energy and Automation, Inc., of Akron, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid submitted for the following equipment for the Oberlin Road Substation 12kv Expansion Project for the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in accordance with their bid of \$20,364.00

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| Item 3 - (3) 250 kVA Voltage Regulators | \$20,364.00 |
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SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to accept a bid prior to its expiration so that the substation expansion project can proceed in a timely fashion"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
