

ORDINANCE NO. 95-92 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 95-79 AC CMS
ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE
CITY OF OBERLIN BIKE PATH
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That paragraphs 1 and 2 of the "Bike Path Rules and Regulations", as established by Ordinance No. 95-79 AC CMS, are hereby amended to read as follows:

1. The Oberlin Bike Path will be operated as a part of the City's park system, except that the hours of use will be from one half hour before sunrise until one half hour after sunset everyday.
2. All other City of Oberlin park rules shall apply.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to amend the hours of use of the Oberlin Bike Path at the earliest possible date to preserve the public peace"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
