

RESOLUTION R95-7

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING COUNCIL'S SUPPORT
OF THE OHIO SCENIC RIVER PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ohio Department of Natural Resources may declare an area to be a wild, scenic, or recreational river area; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin, Ohio, has reason to support the study of the Black River to determine if it qualifies for designation as a wild, scenic, or recreational river area; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of Scenic River designation is to ensure protection of streams in their natural state; and,

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Natural Areas & Preserves requires a majority of directly affected counties, municipalities, and townships to submit a request for the study of any river.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin, acting through its duly elected Council, hereby request the Chief of the Division of Natural Areas & Preserves to study the Black River for designation as a wild, scenic, or recreational river area.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
