## ORDINANCE NO. 96-104 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BUCKEYE OHIO RISK MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION (BORMA) FOR THE FURNISHING AND ADMINISTRATION OF OBERLIN EMPLOYEE MEDICAL BENEFITS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Buckeye Ohio Risk Management Association (BORMA) for the furnishing and administration of City of Oberlin employee medical benefits in accordance with the Intergovernmental Agreement and BORMA Benefit Plan attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to ensure the continuation of City of Oberlin employee medical benefits without interruption",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
