ORDINANCE NO. 96-105 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND MYERS ASSOCIATES, ARCHITECTS, OF MEDINA, OHIO, TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the contract between the City of Oberlin and Myers Associates, architects, of Medina, Ohio, for architectural design services for the proposed addition to the Oberlin Municipal Court, as authorized by Ordinance No. 96-38 AC CMS, is hereby amended to authorize additional compensation of \$3,900 for additional services rendered, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute a change order accordingly.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to allow additional compensation for necessary design services as soon as possible in order to ensure early Spring, 1997, construction of an addition to the Oberlin Municipal Court",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
