ORDINANCE NO. 96-115 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 95-15 AC CMS, THE CITY OF OBERLIN EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 95-5 AC CMS, the City of Oberlin Employee Position Classification Plan, is hereby amended to add a classification of Administration Assistant to Community Services Director and setting the number authorized at one (1) and changing the number of authorized Financial Assistants from three (3) to four (4).

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure the full implementation of the 1997 budget for continued operation of the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
