

ORDINANCE NO. 96-15 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CONTRACT WITH GILLS, GUARD, AND JOHNSON
OF WILLOUGHBY, OHIO, APPROVING CONSULTING ENGINEERING SERVICES
FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 1996 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1996
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the contract agreement with Gills, Guard, and Johnson of Willoughby, Ohio, for engineering consulting services to the City of Oberlin is hereby amended to provide for the following compensation rates for 1996 for approved services:

SECTION 2. That for the period January 1, 1996, through December 31, 1996, the following services are hereby approved:

City Engineer (routine services)	45 days

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to insure the uninterrupted provision of engineering services"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
