

ORDINANCE NO. 96-16 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 92-61 AC CMS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH G&T ASSOCIATED OF STRONGSVILLE, OHIO, FOR THE FURNISHING OF ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PROPOSED WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 92-61 be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with G&T Associates of Strongsville, Ohio, for the furnishing of engineering services to the City of Oberlin, Ohio, for proposed water main improvements in accordance with their proposal dated June 23, 1992, and in an amount not to exceed \$20,500 for Design and \$20,000 for Construction Services, and \$1,000 for Reimbursable Expenses.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to allow for uninterrupted services during construction in accordance with the requirements of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency".

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
