

ORDINANCE NO. 96-27 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STENGER FORD OF DAYTON, OHIO, THROUGH THE STATE OFFICE OF PURCHASING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A POLICE CRUISER FOR THE OBERLIN POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and City of Oberlin Resolution No. R88-7, the Interim City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Stenger Ford of Dayton, Ohio, for the purchase of a 1996 Ford Crown Victoria four-door Sedan for the Oberlin Police Department for a purchase price of \$20,774.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to authorize the purchase of a police cruiser for the Oberlin Police Department as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the police department and protection and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
