

ORDINANCE NO. 96-33 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 94-72 AC CMS WHICH AUTHORIZED A CONTRACT WITH GPD ASSOCIATES OF AKRON, OHIO, FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES RENDERED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 94-72 AC CMS, which authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with GPD Associates of Akron, Ohio, for engineering services relating to the installation of a 2 MW generator at the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power Plant, is hereby amended to authorize additional compensation for additional work performed in the amount of \$55,958.00.

SECTION 2. That said additional sum shall represent full and final payment for all work to be performed by GPD Associates pursuant to its original proposal submitted herein, including completion of Phases I through V regarding said project, in accordance with their correspondence dated March 29, 1996.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"To authorize payment for necessary engineering services as soon as possible in order to avoid additional delays relative to the installation of a new generator at the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power Plant"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
