

ORDINANCE NO. 96-34 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN ADDENDUM TO THE EXISTING  
ENGINEERING CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN  
AND GILLS, GUARD AND JOHNSON, INC., OF WILLOUGHBY, OHIO,  
TO PROVIDE FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE PROPOSED  
IMPROVEMENTS AT THE OBERLIN WASTEWATER TREATMENT  
PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,  
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the existing general engineering services contract between the City of Oberlin and Gills, Guard and Johnson, Inc., of Willoughby, Ohio, dated February 15, 1994, is hereby amended to authorize an addendum, a copy being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to provide for engineering services for the proposed improvements at the Oberlin Wastewater Treatment Plant, in an amount not to exceed \$108,700.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to authorize engineering services as soon as possible in order to comply with EPA mandates in a timely fashion"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
