ORDINANCE NO. 96-41 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FIRE TRAINING FUND FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby established a separate fund account for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to be designated "Fire Training Fund," the purpose of said fund is to separately account for training grants and special training programs.

SECTION 2. That beginning with the 1996 Fiscal Year, there shall be appropriated for and deposited into said fund the grants and contributions so received, and allowable expenditures will be debited. All interest accruing upon said funds in said account shall remain credited to said account.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to authorize a separate fund as soon as possible in order to legally account for the impending revenues and expenditures of State Grant Funds"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
