

ORDINANCE NO. 96-56 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE LYDEN COMPANY OF
BRUNSWICK, OHIO, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Lyden Company of Brunswick, Ohio, for the purchase of motor vehicle fuel for the period July 1, 1996, through June 30, 1997, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, in an amount not to exceed \$37,000.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to purchase the equipment within the time constraints fixed by the competitive bidding process"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
