ORDINANCE NO. 96-57 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF D.B. CONCRETE, INC., OF NEW LONDON, OHIO, FOR CONCRETE WORK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of D.B. Concrete, Inc., of New London, Ohio, for concrete work, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts accordingly, said contracts to be in the following not to exceed amounts and to be paid from the following indicated sources:

- \$50,000 for the construction and/or replacement of sidewalks along.
 City-owned properties. Funds to be supplied through the City's 1/2%.
 Capital Improvement Income Tax.
- \$30,345 for the construction and/or replacement of sidewalks for low and moderate income eligible households. Funds to be provided through the Community Development Block Grant program.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to accept a pending bid prior to its expiration date, and insure the completion of sidewalk replacements during the construction season."

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
