ORDINANCE NO. 96-63 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT WITH AKIL, INC., OF SANDUSKY, OHIO, TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR FORESTRY SERVICES DUE TO UNEXPECTED STORM DAMAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on December 4, 1995, by Ordinance No. 95-107 AC CMS, the City of Oberlin accepted the bid of Akil, Inc., of Sandusky, Ohio, for the furnishing of forestry services to the City of Oberlin for a period of twelve (12) months, through December 31, 1996; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 1996, a violent and unexpected storm hit the City of Oberlin which resulted in extraordinary tree damage within the City and, as a result, extensive clean-up and forestry work; and

WHEREAS, as a result of said damage, it is necessary to provide additional funds for forestry services for the remainder of the 1996 calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That a change order is hereby authorized to the contract for forestry services between the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and Akil, Inc., of Sandusky, Ohio, as approved by Ordinance No. 95-107 AC CMS, in the additional amount of \$8,000 to cover necessary forestry services for the City of Oberlin for the remainder of the 1996 calendar year.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to authorize additional forestry services funds as soon as possible in order to ensure that such services will be available during any emergency situations that may arise during the remainder of the 1996 calendar year",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
