ORDINANCE NO. 96-64 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTS IN REGARD TO THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL COURT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MONROE'S HEATING AND AIR CONDITIONING OF OBERLIN, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the air conditioning system serving the Oberlin Municipal Court recently ceased operating and is not able to be repaired; and,

WHEREAS, the lack of air conditioning directly affects the operation of the Oberlin Municipal Court and represents a real and present emergency arising in connection therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Monroe's Heating and Air Conditioning of Oberlin, Ohio, for the purchase and installation of a 5 ton HVAC unit for Oberlin Municipal Court section of the Oberlin Municipal Building, in accordance with their quote and in an amount not to exceed \$6,888.

SECTION 2. That the immediate need for the replacement of said HVAC unit is hereby declared a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation of the Oberlin Municipal Court and the Oberlin Municipal Building, pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure the safe and efficient operation of the Oberlin Municipal Court and Oberlin Municipal Building"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage,
