AN ORDINANCE INDICATING WHAT SERVICES THE CITY OF OBERLIN WILL PROVIDE TO CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY PROPOSED TO BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN PURSUANT TO SECTION 709.031 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on January 4, 1996, a petition was filed with the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, to annex approximately 41.53 acres of property located in Pittsfield Township to the City of Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, said Petition for Annexation is presently pending before the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, Section 709.031 of the Ohio Revised Code requires that the City of Oberlin adopt a statement indicating what services, if any, the City will provide to the territory proposed for annexation, upon annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin, Ohio, will provide to the real property set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto, upon completion of annexation proceedings and acceptance by the City, all municipal services presently being provided to the residents of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, such including, but not limited to, electric, water, sewer and garbage service, subject, however, to all municipal ordinances and regulations applicable thereto, and further subject to any restrictions due to plant or line capacity or extension cost, as reflected in Exhibit B and Exhibit C attached hereto.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure the adoption of the statement required by Section 709.031 of the Ohio Revised Code prior to the annexation hearing to be held before the Board of Lorain County Commissioners"

EXHIBIT B

UTILITY SERVICE CAPABILITY

PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF APPROXIMATELY 41.53 ACRES LOCATED IN PITTSFIELD TOWNSHIP

1. WATER

A twelve inch water line extends along Rt. 58 the full width of the property. The most recent flow test on this line showed static pressure of 60 p.s.i. and flow of 700 g.p.m. Current usage is limited to the Joint Vocational School, Certified Oil, Ames Department Store, and approximately 12 residentially sized customers.

2. SEWER

A twelve inch sewer line extends along Rt. 58 the full width of the property. Design capacity for a twelve inch line is in excess 1.2 M.G.D. Current usage is limited to the Joint Vocational School, Certified Oil, Ames Department Store, and approximately 12 residentially sized customers.

3. REFUSE

The City operates a municipal refuse and recycling system. Residential customers are charged \$2.50 per household per month. Commercial customers are charged on a volume based, subsidized rate structure.
