

ORDINANCE NO. 96-72 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 751 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN WHICH REGULATES SOLICITATIONS AT
RESIDENCES IN THE CITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 751 of the codified ordinances is hereby amended to substitute "City Manager or his/her designee" for "City Clerk", in Sections 751.02, 751.03(a), 751.04, 751.05, and 751.08, and any other section or subsection of said Chapter wherein "City Clerk" appears.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"To clarify the duties of the City Clerk regarding solicitations at residences within the City at the earliest possible date in order to ensure the efficient operation of Oberlin municipal government"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
