

ORDINANCE NO. 96-88 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 96-34 AC CMS WHICH AUTHORIZED AN ADDENDUM TO THE ENGINEERING CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND GILLS, GUARD AND JOHNSON OF WILLOUGHBY, OHIO, TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 96-34 AC CMS, which authorized an addendum to the engineering contract between the City of Oberlin and Gills, Guard and Johnson of Willoughby, Ohio, to authorize additional compensation for additional services related to the design of improvements to the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant, be and the same is hereby amended to authorize additional compensation for additional work in the amount of \$15,500.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to authorize payment for additional engineering services that are immediately necessary in order to complete plans for improvements at the Wastewater Treatment Plant in accordance with E.P.A. timetables", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
