ORDINANCE NO. 97-109 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER FOR THE 1997 CITY OF OBERLIN STREET RESURFACING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to authorize additional work on Lincoln Street in the amount of \$20,000 for necessary curb replacement, in accordance with the change order attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit;

"to allow the project to proceed in a timely fashion,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
