

ORDINANCE NO. 97-114 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE
CITY OF OBERLIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby established a separate fund account for
the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to be designated "Sidewalk Improvement Fund", the
purpose of said fund to be to provide monies for the orderly and planned
repairs, as designated by the City, of sidewalks throughout the City.

SECTION 2. That beginning with the 1997 calendar year, and continuing
each year thereafter, there shall be appropriated for and deposited into said
fund the repayments to the City for sidewalk repairs and such transfers from the
General Fund as designated by Council. Expenditures from the fund shall be
limited to City designated repairs to privately owned sidewalks in accordance
with Chapter 905 of the Codified Ordinances.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of
this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were
adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this
Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements,
including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date
allowed by law.
