

ORDINANCE NO. 97-119 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLUE & CO., AND GALVAGNI & MILLER OF LOUISVILLE, KENTUCKY, FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES TO PREPARE AN ANALYSIS OF THE PROPOSED EXPANSION TO ALLEN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AND AN ANALYSIS OF THE CURRENT AMBULANCE SERVICE OPERATED BY ALLEN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Blue & Co., and Galvagni & Miller of Louisville, Kentucky, for consultant services to prepare an analysis of the proposed expansion to Allen Memorial Hospital and an analysis of the current ambulance service operated by Allen Memorial Hospital in accordance with their proposal dated November 21, 1997, in an amount not to exceed \$63,925.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"To complete an analysis of the proposed hospital expansion and ambulance service as soon as possible in order to avoid construction delays",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
