

**ORDINANCE NO. 97-13 AC CMS**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 145.09 (a) AND (b) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE CHAIR AND MEMBERS OF OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.** That Sections 145.09 (a) and (b) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, presently reading as follows:

**"145.09 GENERAL PAY PROVISIONS.**

- (a) The salary of the Chairman of Council shall be four thousand dollars (\$4,000) per year. The salary of the Vice-Chairman of Council shall be three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500) per year.**
- (b) The salary of all of the other members of Council shall be three thousand dollars (\$3,000) per year."**

be, and hereby are, amended to read as follows:

**"145.09 GENERAL PAY PROVISIONS.**

- (a) The salary of the Chair of Council shall be five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per year. The salary of the Vice-Chair of Council shall be four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500) per year.**
- (b) The salary of all of the other members of Council shall be four thousand dollars (\$4,000) per year."**

**SECTION 2.** That pursuant to Section III, Paragraph E, of the Charter of the City of Oberlin, said change in salary shall be effective from and after the first Monday in January of 1998.

**SECTION 3.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
