

ORDINANCE NO. 97-17 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE FOUR MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FROM 32 FORD MERCURY INC., OF BATAVIA, OHIO, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF STATE PURCHASING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Resolution R88-7 CMS and Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with 32 Ford Mercury Inc., of Batavia, Ohio, for the purchase of two (2) 1997 F-150 pickup trucks for the sum of \$13,699 each, a 1997 F-250 pickup truck for the sum of \$14,930, and a 1997 E24 Econoline van for the sum of \$14,990.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That the Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to authorize the purchase of necessary equipment as soon as possible to ensure its efficient operation of the City of Oberlin and to protect the health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
