AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE STATE OF OHIO AND THE OBERLIN POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ALLOW PARTICIPATION IN THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE SECTION 1208 SURPLUS PROPERTY PROGRAM

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached memorandum of understanding between the State of Ohio and the Oberlin Police Department to allow said department to participate in the U.S. Department of Defense Section 1208 surplus property program.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
