

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT SURPLUS  
AND NO LONGER SUITABLE OR NECESSARY FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The following pieces of equipment belonging to the City of Oberlin are hereby declared surplus equipment and no longer suitable or necessary for any municipal purpose and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of same pursuant to the provisions of Section 121.03 of the Codified Ordinances:
