

ORDINANCE NO. 97-26 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT WITH AKIL, INC. OF SANDUSKY, OHIO
FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CURBING ON MAIN STREET AND
LORAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, 5/7ths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Akil, Inc., of Sandusky, Ohio, for the installation of curbs on Main Street from College Street north to Maple Street and on Lorain Street from Main Street to Berger Court is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in accordance with same in an amount not to exceed \$254,279.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio to wit:

"to accept a pending bid as soon as possible to ensure completion of the project prior to the resurfacing of the streets by the Ohio Department of Transportation"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
