

ORDINANCE NO. 97-38 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER WITH SUTPHEN CORPORATION OF AMLIN, OHIO, FOR ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY REPAIR WORK TO THE OBERLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT AERIAL FIRE TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to approve a change order for additional emergency repairs to the Oberlin Fire Department Aerial Fire Truck with Sutphen Corporation of Amlin, Ohio, in accordance with the proposed change order of March 1, 1997, in an amount not to exceed \$7010.

SECTION 2. That said additional repairs are hereby declared an emergency arising in connection with the safe and efficient operation of the Oberlin Municipal Fire Department, pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure the continued safe and efficient operation of the Oberlin Municipal Fire Department, and to protect the health and safety of the residents of Oberlin, Ohio", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
