

ORDINANCE NO. 97-46 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF D.B. CONCRETE, INC., OF NEW LONDON, OHIO, FOR SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION AND REPLACEMENT FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of D.B. Concrete, Inc., of New London, Ohio, for concrete sidewalk construction and replacement, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said contract to be in an amount not to exceed \$16,000., and at the per square foot costs as set forth in their bid.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, to wit:

"to accept a pending bid prior to its expiration date, and ensure the completion of sidewalk replacements prior to the onset of inclement weather"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
