

ORDINANCE NO. 97-53 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTS IN REGARD TO VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ERIE SHORES COMPUTERS, INC. OF ELYRIA, OHIO, FOR COMPUTER EQUIPMENT AND A COMPUTER NETWORKING SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and City of Oberlin Resolution No. R88-7, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Erie Shores Computers, Inc. of Elyria, Ohio, for the purchase of computer equipment and a computer networking system in accordance with their quote of April 15, 1997, in an amount not to exceed \$30,655.

SECTION 2. That the immediate need for said purchase is hereby declared an emergency arising in connection with the safe and efficient operation of the City of Oberlin pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure the efficient operations of municipal government and secure system purchase discounts"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
