ORDINANCE NO. 97-68 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ERIE BLACKTOP, INC., OF SANDUSKY, OHIO, FOR THE RESURFACING OF VARIOUS STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Erie Blacktop, Inc., of Sandusky, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid submitted for the resurfacing of Artino Street, Lincoln Street, Washington Circle, Roosevelt Court, Monroe Court, and modifications to the Oberlin Road/State Route 511 intersection, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in accordance with their bid and in an amount not to exceed \$255,674.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to enter into a contract within time constraints fixed by the competitive bidding process",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
