## ORDINANCE NO. 97-7 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF EDWARD'S TREE SERVICE, INC., OF AMHERST, OHIO, FOR FORESTRY SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohlo, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Edward's Tree Service, Inc., of Amherst, Ohio, for forestry services for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, for a period of twelve (12) months, beginning January 1, 1997, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being as follows:

## WORK ITEM

Projected Tree Removals (58 trees)
Emergency Bid Rate (20 hours)
Stump ONLY removals (110 inches or 5 hours)

## **BID AMOUNT**

\$41,540.00

\$160.00 per hour (\$3200.00) \$2.25 per inch (\$247.50)

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to accept a forestry bid as soon as possible in order to ensure emergency tree clearing and removal services during the winter months", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
